Job Purpose

- To play a part in serving God's transformation of the North at The Belfrey
- To lead the student life of The Belfrey

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Leadership of student ministry
- Discipleship in student ministry
- Evangelism and mission in student ministry

Leadership

- To lead the student life of St Michael le Belfrey.
- To lead the student team of The Belfrey (Consisting of New Wine DY Interns, Leadership Interns, Key Volunteers and a wider leadership team of 30 small group leaders)
- To take an active role in the shaping and direction of The6 congregation
- To be imaginative, creative and pioneering in leading students in missional engagement
- To cast the vision for the student ministry
- Commit to attending Fusion Student Work training, development days and conferences
- To maintain and continue to develop our networks (In particular with Fusion, UCCF, New Wine, LICC and Chaplaincies)
- To have Pastoral Oversight of the students at The Belfrey – including Pastoral Triage and signposting when situations arise.

Discipleship

- Oversee and disciple the student team
- Identify and raise up leaders within the student community
- Serve the student community of The Belfrey
- Release students to serve the wider church community
- Be responsible for developing and ensuring good discipleship within the student small group and Belfrey Group structure
- To run and develop the events programme (Currently including, but not limited to: Student Alpha, Student Worship Nights and conferences)
- Maintain the Student Social Network resources (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter etc)

Evangelism & Mission

- To be able to think creatively about evangelism amongst students in York and the North
- To release the evangelistic and missional imagination amongst students who are part of The Belfrey
- To be committed to giving every student in York an opportunity to respond to the good news of Jesus Christ
- Committed to The Belfrey and Church of England's vision to plant churches
- To set a culture of hospitality, community and invitation within the student work at St Michael le Belfrey

The above job description is not exhaustive and the post-holder should expect to carry out further reasonable duties as required by the Line Manager.

The post-holder will be part of the church's Staff Team of The Belfrey (staff meeting on Monday morning) and will be a committed Christian and a person of prayer, committed to the vision and values of The Belfrey.
